



Staying in Touch Around the Globe

Whether calling from abroad in more than 200 countries or calling from within the U.S. to more than 220 countries, AT&T customers benefit from competitive calling plans to help them stay connected with friends and family wherever they are. From traditional wireline calls to wireless calls to operator-assisted calls, it's important to know the options.

Wireless

AT&T's wireless customers enjoy the most robust selection of world phones and international discount calling plans, along with the best global coverage of any wireless provider. With voice service in more than 200 countries and data service (email, Web browsing) in more than 150 countries, AT&T customers can travel around the globe and make and receive calls on the same wireless number they use at home. AT&T also offers voice and data roaming coverage on 120 major cruise ships. In addition, AT&T offers ultra-fast 3G network speeds in more than 60 countries, including Japan and South Korea.

Making International Calls from the U.S.

AT&T World Connect. It's easy and convenient to make international calls from your mobile phone. This plan offers discounted per-minute rates on long distance calls from the U.S. to 220 countries for just \$3.99 a month.

Calling and Traveling in North America

AT&T Mexico. For \$4.99 a month, customers receive discounted rates when they travel to or call Mexico.

AT&T Canada. For \$3.99 a month, customers receive discounted rates when they travel to or call Canada.

Using Your Mobile Device Abroad

AT&T World Traveler. For \$5.99 a month, customers receive discounted calling rates when traveling in more than 85 countries.

BlackBerry International. Customers can send and receive unlimited e-mail on AT&T BlackBerry devices in the U.S. and in more than 150 countries for \$64.99 a month with any AT&T wireless voice plan.

PDA/Smartphone/iPhone International Data Plans. Travelers who need to work while vacationing can take advantage of discounted international data plans in 67 countries. PDA and smartphone users can choose from a 20MB plan for an additional \$24.99 a month or a 50MB plan for an additional \$59.99 a month. iPhone users can also choose from a 100MB plan for an additional \$119.99 per month, and a 200MB plan for an additional \$199.99 per month.

International DataConnect Plans. While abroad, travelers can maintain wireless connectivity to work or home with a laptop card. For \$109.99 a month, customers receive 5 GB of data in the U.S. plus 100MB in Canada and Mexico. For \$139.99 a month, customers receive 5 GB of data in the U.S. plus 100MB in 67 countries, or for \$229.99 a month, customers receive 5 GB of data in the U.S. plus 200MB in 67 countries.

Text, Picture and Video Messaging. AT&T customers can send a text message from abroad for 50 cents a message, and they can send picture or video messages for \$1.30 a message. Home pay-per-use or package rates apply to messages received abroad. Many customers enjoy the freedom of sending a text message or e-mail anytime to stay in touch with friends and family in the U.S. while traveling in a foreign time zone.

Making International Calls from the U.S.

AT&T Unity Worldwide Calling. Our best overall international long distance calling rates to more than 220 countries, including Mexico, Canada, Japan, Australia and France, from a traditional wireline or a wireless phone. It's one international calling plan for both your home and wireless phones for just \$4.99 a month.

AT&T Worldwide Value Calling. For callers who frequently make international calls from the U.S., using a traditional wired phone, this plan offers some of the best international calling rates from the U.S. The cost is \$5 a month, and, provides discounted rates for direct-dialed calls made to more than 220 countries.

AT&T Worldwide Occasional Calling. An international calling plan for \$1 a month. Best for those who make occasional international calls, Worldwide Occasional Calling delivers a discount on basic rates for direct-dialed calls from the U.S. to more than 220 countries. This plan is for traditional wireline calls.

Making Calls from Abroad

AT&T USADirect Savings Plan. This is the plan available to anyone -- not just AT&T customers. Using an access number, call from more than 140 countries to and from the U.S. for only 99 cents per minute, (35 cents per minute from Canada and Mexico), plus a low 89 cents per-call service charge. The savings can equate to more than 50 percent for wireline calls made back to the U.S.
